INSTRUCTIONS FOR 14TH CONVOCATION CEREMONY 2026

1. Award of Degrees

- Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) students shall be awarded their degrees in Presentia (in person) during the Convocation Ceremony.
- Ph.D. scholars shall be awarded their degrees In Absentia (in absence).

2. Instructions for UG and PG Students (In Presentia)

- Eligible students must attend the Convocation Ceremony in person to receive their degrees.
- It is mandatory to complete prior registration as per the schedule notified by the University.
- Students must report at the venue at the specified date, time and wear the prescribed academic dress.
- Entry to the venue will not be permitted after the stipulated reporting time.
- Students who fail to attend the ceremony shall collect their degree certificates from the University office as per the prescribed procedure.

3. Instructions for Ph.D. Scholars (In Absentia)

- Their degrees shall be conferred in absentia as per the approved format of the Convocation ceremony and the decision of the competent authority.
- The Degree Certificate shall be dispatched to the registered address of the Ph.D. scholar by Speed Post within the next 10-15 working days from the date of the Convocation Ceremony.
- In case of any change in address, the scholar must inform the University in writing before the ceremony.

4. General Instructions

- Maintain the decorum in the Convocation Hall throughout the ceremony.
- **Parents will not be permitted inside the Convocation Hall.**
- Convocation Ceremony detailed guidelines and updates shall be made available on the University website.
- The decision of the University authorities regarding the conduct of the Convocation shall be final and binding.
- **A security deposit of Rs. 500/- will be collected for the convocation gown, out of which Rs. 300/- will be refunded after the ceremony upon returning the gown and cap without any damage.**
- Occupy your seat in the convocation hall by 9:00 AM
- Due to security check reach the gate of the Convocation Hall early.
- Cameras are prohibited in the Convocation Hall. Mobile phones should be kept in silent mode.
- Maintain sanctity of the occasion in the Convocation Hall.
- The candidate will go to the dais when he/she is called by the HoD/Dean, receive the degree certificate and leave the dais to occupy his/her seat. Same way, the toppers will receive their medals.
- On the procession entering the Convocation Hall, all assembled will rise and remain standing until the Senators forming the procession have taken their seats.
- Ceremony venue – Smt. Bhagwani Devi Basantilal Goenka Auditorium at Shri JYT University.
- No accommodation will be provided to the students.
- Lunch will be provided on 26th February 2026 only for students.
- Any type of water bottle, foods, luggage bag is not allowed in the Convocation Hall.
