#### **About the conference:**

The right to life is a fundamental principle of international human rights law. Article 3, of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights states that, "everyone has the right to life, liberty, and security of person." Article 6(1) of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR) provides that "every human being has the inherent right to life" which is to be "protected by law," and "no one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his life." and in Humanitarian law is a key legal framework that provides crucial safeguards to people affected by armed conflicts. This conference overview, some of the main provisions of 'Right to Life and International Humanitarian Law' that may be particularly relevant during the COVID-19 pandemic. The right to health, public health and COVID-19: a discourse on the importance of the enforcement of humanitarian and human rights law in conflict settings for the future

management of zoonotic pandemic diseases. States' shortcomings in protecting populations under their care from the threat of COVID-19 may violate a fundamental right in international human rights law: the right to life. This right is considered a core right that governments have a duty to protect and an obligation not to infringe. This conference is the platform where paper presentation will discuss about international human rights affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and government responses thereto. It first outlines the right to life as it is defined and protected in various human rights conventions. COVID-19 represents a dramatic new threat to life in war-torn countries. It then considers the scope of State obligations related to the right in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. In light of claims that countries are culpable for the virus' impact on other States when they have failed to prevent COVID-19's spread beyond their borders, this conference also looking for multidisciplinary discussion through various aspects of the right to life and its application to the current pandemic.
